The only difference in seasonal variations exists in the 2-measure intro and 2-measure outro.

Thus, the player is to choose a season, and apply the appropriate intro and outro to the measures that exist right before and after the theme. The resulting work should be: "Chosen intro"- "Theme"- "Chosen outro". Each outro is to repeat back directly to the theme, not to the intro.
